

Foreword

I feel honoured to present to you this 36th catalog of our art exhibitions. I feel proud about reminding you that this exhibition has been held consecutively for 36 years by the Artists Association of the Punjab with only the Covid epidemic forcing a break.

Although it-is the Punjab Artists' Association it has included and encouraged artists from all provinces to participate in this yearly event, because now all provinces have formed a separate Association of their own province. And all these independent provincial associations are joined together under the National Artists Association.

In the current year, three important exhibitions were organised by the components of the National Artists Association. The present exhibition organised by the Punjab Artists Association is the fourth. A national exhibition was organised at Karachi, that included the works of all the Provincial Artists' Associations.

And an exhibition based on the works of the Artists Association of KPK during their workshops and stay in the northern areas. The exhibition of these works were held at the Coopera art gallery, the Mall Lahore.

I have no hesitation in asserting that the four Provincial Associations have played an important role in interconnecting the artists of the provinces and major cities of the country. The artists' Association of Punjab made the commendable eff ort to take their annual exhibition to other smaller cities of the Province. Cities like Bahawalpur, Multan, Faisalabad, Sargodha, Rawalpindi and Murree. They also organised a national exhibition at the PNCA. All these exhibitions attracted a large aaudience. People who attended, thanked the association. And in two cities the exhibitions created so much interest that eventually resulted in the opening of art departments in their major educational institutions .

In addition to these exhibitions the Association has continuously taken notice and held special shows to highlight the terrible and tragic events that happen in various countries around the world. In this reference I would like to particularly mention our Association's concern for brutalities in Kashmir, Burma, Palestine and held special exhibitions of paintings of protests against such barbarities. When the attack on the Peshawar school took place the Punjab Artists Association held an exhibition in Lahore as well as in Islamabad. The horror of the event was also highlighted by a huge mural jointly painted by fi fteen members of the Fine Arts faculty of Lahore College for Women University, initiated, supported and painted by some members of the Punjab Artists Association

The Seminar group of the Artists' Association of Punjab has also initiated a project of data collection. Complete collection of Data of members of the association is already underway. After that full data of other artists who are not members will also be collected. We plan to involve other provinces to collect the data of the artists of their own province. This is a decades old project of the Association that has been delayed due to lack of funding, despite repeated requests to diff erent departments. We have started this project now with our own resources with the hope that it will continue to grow and a respectable data base be eventually built so as to gain respect for all our artists of Pakistan, which they have richly deserved for so many generations.

With the initiation of Mrs Amina Pataudi, the The Association was successful in sending paintings to Africa in collaboration with the For Art's Sake. The Association also collaborated with Artists of Australia to protest against the genocide in Kashmir and sent digital paintings to participate in a show that was organised for this specific purpose.

This year the Punjab Artists Association has a new elected President Mrs Amina Pataudi. As the outgoing President I would like to welcome and congratulate her. I would also like to thank Mr Ghulam Mustafa who for 36 years has stood by me as my general secretary and is still by my side as my secretary General in the National Artists Association. And of course thanks are due to each member for being part of the team. As I have expressed in many of my paintings


